End your day dining at one of Barcelona's stylish restaurants, enjoying delectable cuisine and cocktails.



Spend your morning exploring *Montjuïc*, a historic hill offering panoramic views of Barcelona, where you can visit the *Montjuïc Castle*, the *Magic Fountain* and the beautiful *Joan Miró Foundation*. Afterward, enjoy lunch at *Can Fisher*, specializing in Mediterranean seafood with stunning views. In the evening, head to *Paradiso*, a hidden speakeasy-style bar, for inventive cocktails and a unique night out.





If you haven't explored *Barcelona's shopping scene* yet, your last day is the perfect time. Each neighborhood offers its own distinct vibe. In the *Gothic Quarter*, winding streets are lined with boutique shops offering everything from vintage finds to artisanal crafts. *El Raval* is vibrant and edgy, known for quirky stores and galleries. *Eixample* features elegant, high-end shopping along wide avenues with designer boutiques. For a bohemian touch, head to *El Born*, famous for its stylish, trendy shops.
